Outline of the Course

- Introduction to Legal Thinking (2 hrs)

Introduction to the structure of law, international law, and introduction to case briefing methodology.

- Business Law Case Analysis (3 hrs)

This section aims to improve the legal thinking abilities of participants by an examination and discussion of real business law cases. It utilizes the law school Socratic Method to discuss concepts in contract law.

- Exploration of CISG (3 hrs)

This section delves into international law practices in sales of goods, centered around a discussion of the United Nations Covenant on the International Sales of Goods.
